

USING THE MIDI FILES

To access the MIDI file you want:

- Right-click the song title on the [Keyquest Music KEYBAND!](#) web page
- Choose to “Save target as...” from the dropdown menu
- Check the name and location where you wish to save it
- Click “OK”.

Once the MIDI file is saved on your computer you will need to transfer the file to the portable media storage that your keyboard supports. This is most likely to be a “USB” key (thumb-drive), but might be a floppy-disc on older keyboards, or other media storage.

Transfer the MIDI file(s) to your keyboard by plugging the USB key (or other media).

The song title(s) should then be accessible by your keyboard.

To simply listen to the track, first select it and then press the “Song Play” button.

Many keyboards will also allow you to switch the different parts ON/OFF. This is very useful when practising because you can (for example):

- Remove all the parts except the auto-accompaniment while practising your own right-hand part
- Remove just your own part and play along with the MIDI file, hearing how your part fits with the rest of the band
- Listen to any part in isolation
